Mission and profile

The post-doctoral researcher will participate in the ANR grant on firm responsibility (RESPGLOB)'s research program. This includes participating in constructing and manipulating new databases on outsourcing and corporate responsibility commitments monitored over time, conducting empirical econometric work using panel data at the company level, and developing trade models featuring responsible companies and outsourcing.

The candidate should hold a PhD in Economics, have strong analytical skills, and a high standard of research excellence. She/he should have the ability to work effectively, both independently and collaboratively, as part of an international team.
